Parent/Family Building Capacity Trainings: To support student learning at home, parents will be able to have a deeper understanding of ELA and math curriculum such as Letter recognition-upper lower case, high frequency words, number recognition, and writing number 0-20. Parents will be provided with the tools and strategies to help their children academically at home. o support student learning at home, parents will participate in a variety of standards based games and activities that focus on Math: Algebraic thinking, measurement, data and geometry. Coordination and Integration: Cholee Lake staff collaborates with the Multicultural Department in working with parents for effective communication. ESOL staff conducts multiple open houses throughout the year to showcase the Dual Language program, best practices for all students as well

as involving parents within the school. Cholee Lake works with the Department of Early Childhood Education and follows all statutes, rules and contractual mandates in the Florida VPK Statewide Provider Agreement, including the use of a developmentally appropriate curriculum that enhances the age appropriate progress of children in attaining each of the performance standards adopted by the Florida DOE. Lois' Food 4 Kids is a year-round weekend feeding program for children. Cholee Lake families will receive a weekend's worth of nutritious, shelf-stable food.

Communication: Cholee Lake Elementary provides childcare during each parent training as well as, Title I Annual Meeting, SAC, and other parent only sponsored events. The school will make home visits for those parents not able to attend parent conferences. Activities at the school will also be staggered in time to allow multiple parents to attend. Accessibility: Cholee Lake will provide translation of parent meetings, correspondence and events with Community Language Facilitators.
